1953 Medium R/G in original excellent dark oak box. The parts are largely unused, complete with all four

1956 Medium R/G in original excellent dark oak box. The parts are unused, still strung with all manuals and leaflets. This condition rarely seen these days. £2,400

1926/27 outfit No. 7 - "First coloured Meccano". Pea green/red/nickel. The largest, most comprehensive outfit of the time in its very good original oak cabinet with two drawers and all four original handles. This exceptionally rare item was marketed for less than one year, during a period of world recession. Therefore few could have been sold. The parts are in excellent condition and the contents are complete apart from the accumulator and one instruction leaflet. This outfit featured at the Didcot centenary Meccano exhibition, in 2001.

1931 No. 6 in very good original oak box. Good parts and manuals. $\pounds 625$

1928 No. 5 in good black carton with excellent parts, many are unused. The top tray wheel card is original and restrung. The manuals and "standard mechs" are excellent.

1928 No. 4. Excellent carton with mint label. Parts are very little used. The wheel card display is almost mint. There are three excellent manuals and includes a digger bucket and special screwdriver. A fine collector's item.

1930 No. 3A. Very good parts and carton and includes a 4/7 manual. ± 90

1928 No. 2A. Very good carton, parts and manual. £55

1934 No. 2A. Good carton with excellent label. Very good parts including R/G boiler. £60

1916 No. 6 wartime outfit. The pristine "presentation walnut" box has a rare type of lid which is only a piece of polished 1/2" plywood. But it does have the "Meccano No. 6" gold transfers on both sides. The parts and manuals are excellent. There is a lock and key. A rare collector's item.

1922 No. 5A in large very good black carton. The parts are in the very top condition and include an original theodolite protractor. £250

1912 No. 5 in excellent "walnut" cabinet. All the tunnel fixed brass parts are mounted on pins underneath a xylonite window with a hinged mahogany frame. There are lots of the rare tunnel keys, very rare original chain and an excellent complete "windmill" manual. A rare (in this condition) fine collector's item.

1916 No. 5 in excellent oak box. Very good parts, manual and very rare types of two S.P.B.'s. Another fine collector's item. £475

1924 No. 5 in very good large black carton. The parts, manual and S.P.B.'s are excellent. £240

1910 No. 4A in original dark wooden cabinet with ornamental drop handles. Includes a hinged glass panel over all the tunnel fixed brass parts. Very good condition parts. There is even a lock - on a 4A set!! This is a very rare item, when most would have opted for the cheaper carton option. £450

1912 No. 4A transitional (A mixture of tunnel and set screw bosses). Excellent parts (many still blackened) and box. A very rare outfit. £125

1913 No. 3 good hinged-lid, two layered carton brass parts (mint) are still on their cards. Rare very good manual. Good parts. £65

1908 No. 2 labelled "Meccano (mechanics made easy)" matchbox style box with good 'boy/girl' label. Good parts but one corner of box is repaired. Quite rare now. £195

1909 No. 1 in good matchbox style carton. Tunnel-fixing parts with black strips and plates in very good condition. Includes rare windmill type of manual. £90

1908 "No. 2A transition outfit" in "mechanics made easy" tin box with diagonal sash stating "Meccano accessory outfit to convert No. 2 to No. 3". This is an example of Hornby using up his stock of tins to take the new numbered sets. Gears and wheels are still tunnel fixed. Very good condition. £1,200

1912 No. 0 "Royal Meccano" in its very good tin. The excellent parts include an unused card of cord and a complete 'O' set S.P.B. Packet. Includes 'O' outfit manual. £525

1920 electrical outfit No X2, in a very good box with complete clear label. The parts card (including all four S.P.B.'s) is mint unstrung. There is no accumulator but the nickel motor is excellent. The electrical manual is also excellent.

1934 aero outfit No. 1. Good blue /white parts in a poor box (lid no flanges) to clear. £60

1932 aero outfit No. 1A. In a reasonable box with excellent label, the good red/silver parts are restrung onto the original card. £170

1935 No. 1s special aero outfit in a good box with very good labels the red/cream/blue parts are generally excellent and the manual and S.P.B's are near mint. Stringing card is still there.

1934 motor car lighting set in a mint box with excellent parts restrung. There are the instructions sheet and the original invoice from Binns Road. A fine collector's item. £220

1937 lighting set, in a very good box. The excellent parts are restrung. The instructions sheet is also included. £140

1935 Dinky builder No. 1 outfit. The very good box contains the mint, still strung, parts along with the instructions sheet. There is also a rare "Dinky builder super models" leaflet. £90

A SELECTION OF RARE ITEMS:

1912 Meccano butterchurn, boxed. This now very rare item is in excellent condition and includes the original glass beaker and instruction sheet. These are rarely seen these days.

1915 saw bench, boxed. This is a mint condition example - superb! £350

1920 steam engine, boxed in very good condition. This very rare item is totally complete with its burner, funnel, beaker and instruction sheet. A very fine and rare collector's item. Box is very good. £1,900

1929 steam engine. A truly outstanding boxed example as near mint as it's possible to find. Complete with burner, funnel, spanner and spare wick and washers. The instruction manual is near mint. Also included is a rare spare parts price list leaflet. A very fine collector's item.
